

Slogan buses hit the streets

TRANSPORT Bus operators are stepping up their fight against the state government's plan to take over their businesses, by driving the first of several anti-Labor buses through marginal electorates ahead of this year's election. The operators are refusing to sign up to new contracts that would see their bus fleets, depots, staff and intellectual property rights handed to the government within 10 years. Yesterday, they launched protest action by driving a 'Don't trust Labor' bus along the Nepean Highway between Elsternwick and Frankston.
